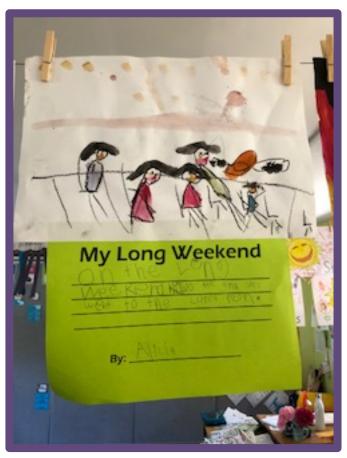
EKINDERGARTEN: korner

On the long weekend my aunty and uncle went to the Korean restaurant.



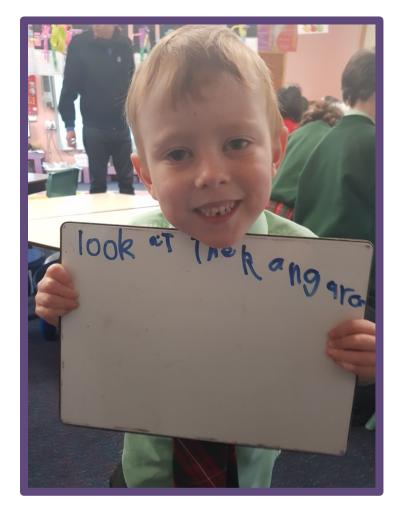
On the long weekend my friends came over to my home and we made a puzzle and we watched and we played.

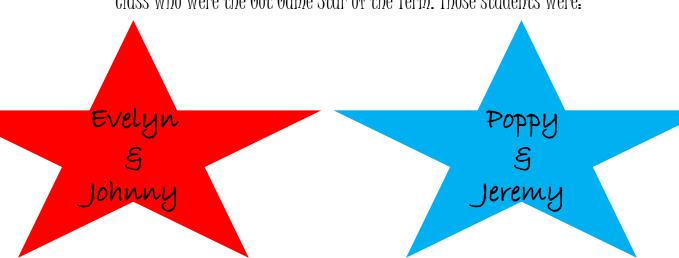
Creating Oxygen Experiment
