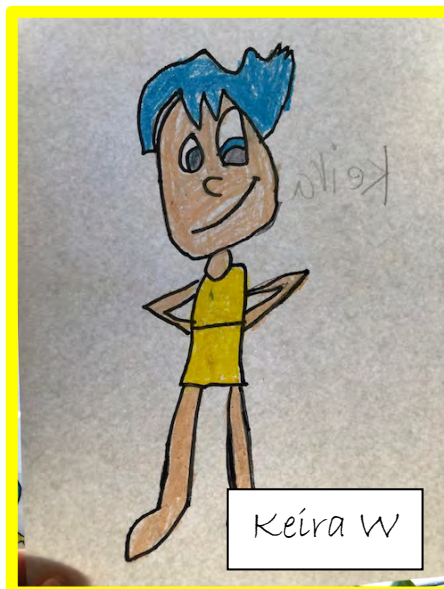
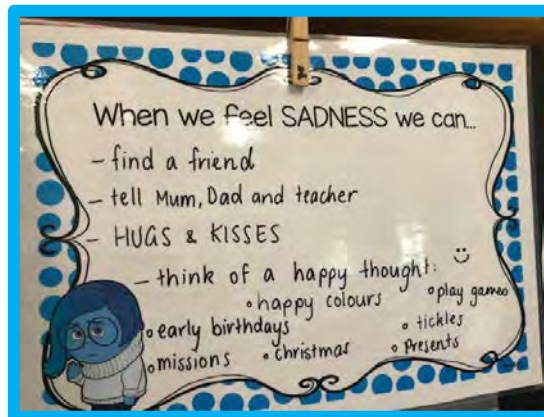
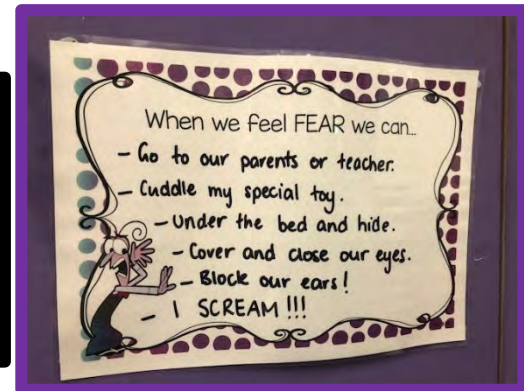


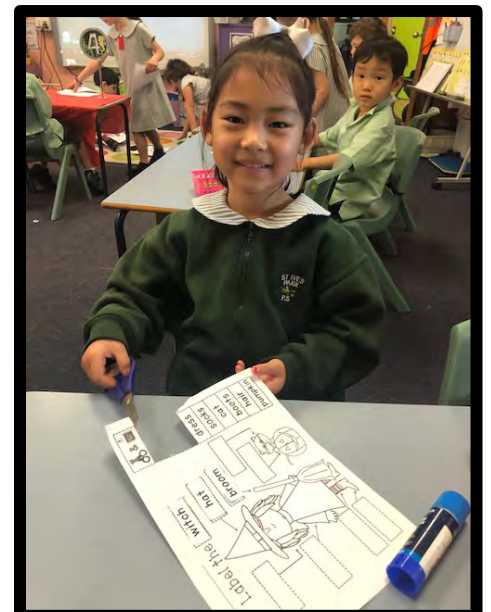
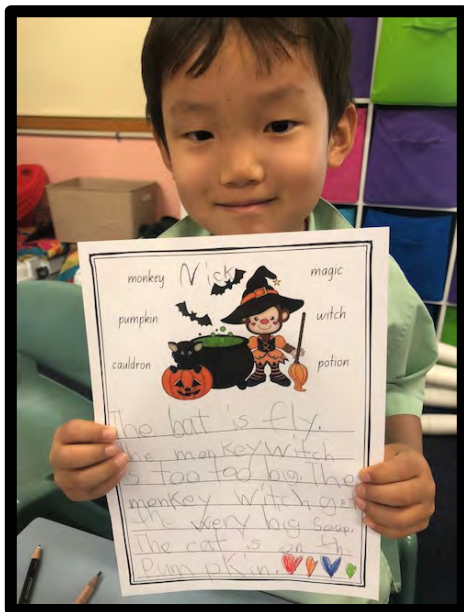


KINDERGARTEN

For Maths, we looked at Mass and all the different ways we can measure the mass of an object, by hefting, using a pan balance and pushing and pulling. Also in Kindergarten this term we have been looking at the different characters from the movie 'Inside Out' and talking about all the different emotions and things we can do to help us deal with these emotions.





We did lots of fun activities during Literacy Groups for Halloween. We wrote secret, spooky messages in white oil pastels and then painted over the top in watercolour paint to reveal the message. 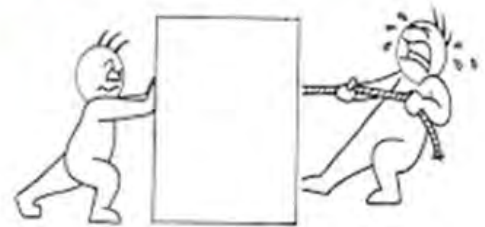
